What can you do this week to invest in your closest relationships – especially your marriage?

# Commit this Week

Will you commit to loving well by renewing your commitment toward, your pursuit of, and your sacrifice for those who are closest to you? If married, will you commit to investing toward greater closeness with your spouse?
