"He is not here, for he has risen, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay." (Matthew 28:6, ESV)

## Review the Sermon Read Mt. 28:1-20. Why would Jesus select unlikely witnesses to carry the message of his Resurrection? Why is experience vital to being a witness? What were the guards missing in their experience of the Resurrection? Assess your Life Where have you experienced God's resurrection power in your own life? How has the Resurrection helped you to accept the prospect of your own mortality? Are there any areas of temptation you fear could lead you away from faithful Christian witness?
