What role does prayer and the Word play in your resistance against temptations?

Apply the Truth

Identify key strategies that a church can implement to fight (as a community) against temptations.

What specific voices do you need to remove from your life to help you resist temptation?

How can you replace those tempting voices with voices speaking truth?

Commit this Week

Will you commit this week to filtering out voices that lead you into sin, and replacing them with voices that encourage your walk with God?
