"Hear, my son, and be wise, and direct your heart in the way."
(Proverbs 23:19, ESV)

Review the Sermon Read Proverbs 23:1-35. Why is it not sound advice to trust your heart and follow your instincts? What aspects of life in the real world do Proverbs 23 present as needing self-control? What does it look like to lead your heart rather than following it? Assess your Life In what areas of life do you struggle most with following your heart and giving in to your feelings?
